## Registration and Payment

All registration and payment will be handled by the NSOs/MOs. The appropriate forms will be accessible on the website, and we will also e-mail them to the contact persons mentioned earlier. In order to make the registration process clear and smooth, the Euro-Mini-Jam planning team will not receive any individual registration or payment – everything must be handled by the NSOs/MOs.

Don't forget to send us a roughly estimated number of participants by January 15th. The deadline for official registration, along with the confirmation fee, is April 1st.
